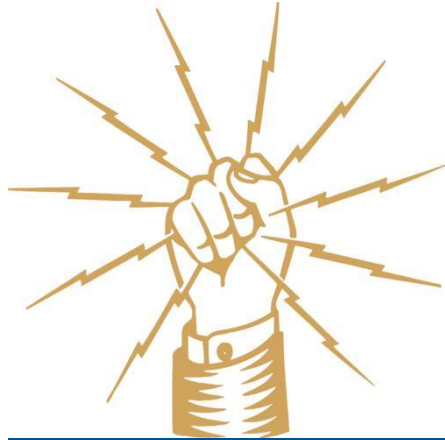


LOCAL 760 WEBSITE
